BiblioPRO (http://www.bibliopro.org) is the only virtual library of tools in Spanish for health-related quality of life (HRQOL) and other patient reported outcomes (PRO). These tools are used worldwide to measure aspects relating to the health of individuals and, for example, they enable knowing the effectiveness and efficacy of treatments, the health status of the population or of an individual, and the impact of health policies.

To know what tools are available, currently requires bibliographical searches in large databases. Identifying the versions in Spanish is even more complex, and makes it difficult to **identify, select and access the most adequate tool**. BiblioPRO facilitates this process while controlling intellectual property protection legal requirements. The process of accessing, distributing and expert advice is done easily and practically through a website which, during its first year of existence (2005) and with only 30 available questionnaires, registered 1500 downloads.

The new website, which has been functioning since December 2011, allows intellectual proprietors of questionnaires to choose from several publishing options: open access, access through permission for use, access after payment, with prices that are differentiated according to the academy, and their public or private sphere.

Currently, BiblioPRO provides scientific information for over 600 questionnaires in Spanish, of which 25%, including SF-12 and Family SF, may be downloaded directly online.
